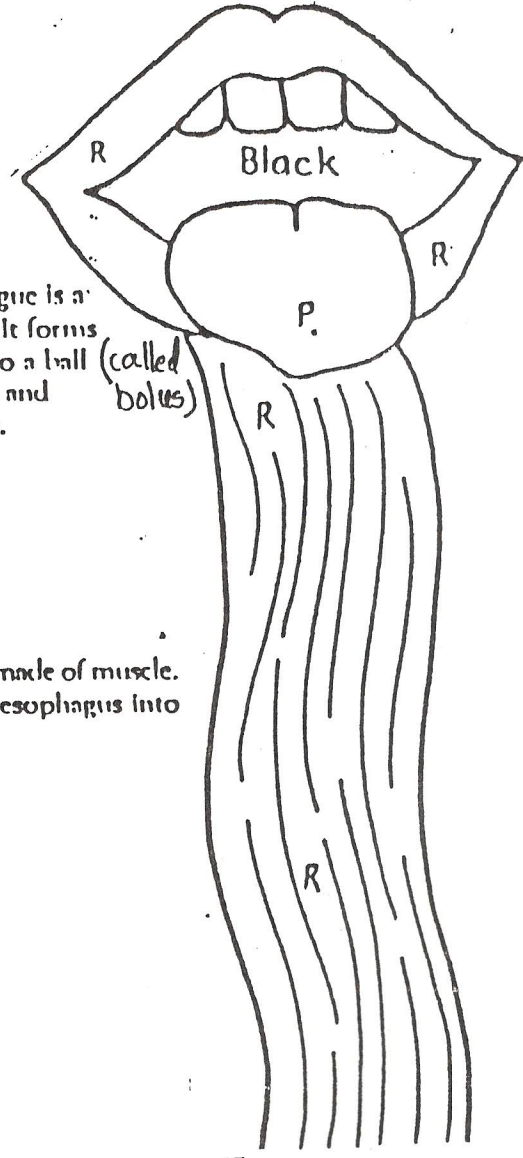


the blood from the large intestine.
